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CONTEXT

MAIN ACTIVITIES:

- Site-visits to samples of sustainable schools or to schools which have sustainable practices will be visited by Master's students together with some of the project experts.
- Summer schools will be organized with the participation of experts, invited speakers from academic world, local and state-level policy makers of education, civil servants from different institutions, community actors and media in order to establish a dialogue between academia and society.
- A project final summit will be organized at the end of the project aiming at bringing academia and civil society actors together and disseminating the project outcomes to wider society.
